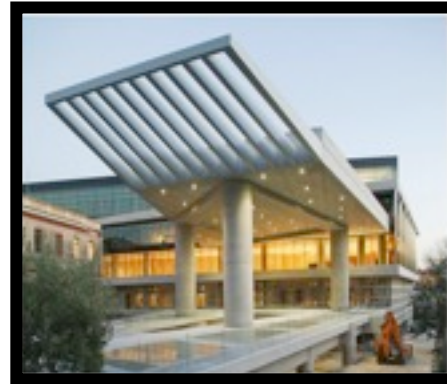

Suggested Itinerary

3 Days – 2 nights

Day 1

- Arrival to Athens International Airport. Our English or Dutch speaking welcome staff will meet the group at the airport for transfer to Hotel in the Centre of Athens or Sea Side.
 - Check in at the hotel
 - Athens City tour by bicycle to explore the highlights of the city center – Visit of the Acropolis and its new Museum
- Dinner at Krithamos Restaurant serving delicious food from Crete and the small island of Karpathos

Day 2

Full day excursion to the island of Aegina by

1. Flying Dolphin - duration one way (45 minutes)
2. Sailing boats - duration one way (2-3hours)
3. Private Cruise boat – duration 1 hour

On Aegina we will meet local fishermen and go out fishing with small traditional fishing boats. Catch of the day will be grilled at local taverna situated on the seaside where a typical meze lunch will be served.

Transportation and assistance staff



- All transfers are be conducted by air-conditioned, deluxe coaches and multilingual welcome staff. If passengers do not arrive on the same flight, transportation to/from hotel can be operated by private taxis (1-3 pax), 20-seater coach (up to 14 pax), 30-seater coach (up to 28 pax), and 50seater coach (up to 45 pax)

Full Day Cruise to Aegina

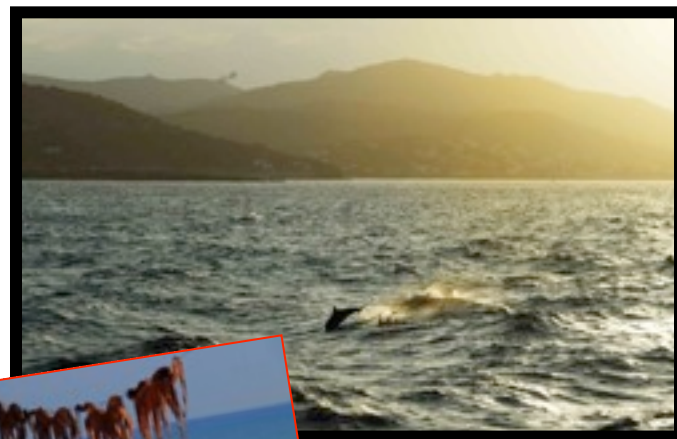
ISLAND LIFE SITUATED A MERE STONE'S THROW AWAY FROM ATHENS. . .

Attika Road Rally

Quality, time management and creativity are the mark of our Road Rally program. Teams in this adventure navigate their way through roadways, **by 4x4 jeeps**, on road or off the beaten path. Each team receives a set of instructions (Road Book) containing directions to checkpoints they must locate along the trail that leads to their final destination.

Our destination is Cape Sounio where you will discover one of Ancient Greece's most famous temples with the help of a guide.

The journey to Cape Sounio and beyond will take us through some of the typical, local villages of the Attica region. In particular, enjoy the beautiful beaches and reflection of the blue sky in the sea, whilst admiring the ancient olive trees that grace the surrounding hillsides. The journey through the National Park of Sounio will take the contenders through dirt tracks which they have to navigate using their off-road driving skills, the team members acting as the extra pairs of eyes the drivers need in these situations.

The Sounion Road Rally can be accompanied (at extra cost) by additional events or tasks for the teams to complete. These can include team-building events, which can be located at a secluded spot inside the National Park or even at the site of the Temple, or a question booklet which the teams can work on during the fabulous Road Trip.



Vlachika

Vári is a small town situated on the western side of Attiki peninsula, not far from the seaside resorts Vouliagameni and Varkiza, but inland. It is famous for many meat restaurants alongside the highway, as you see in the photo above. Many Athenians come here for meat feast on weekends. Not particularly a foreign tourists' attraction.

The meat kitchen, where animal carcasses are dissected and cooked, is separated from the back kitchen, is placed in front of the restaurant so that the passers-by and the diners can see it. It looks more like a butcher shop than a restaurant kitchen.
